The pread of life...

August marks the start of the harvest season. Hard to imagine, because harvest is associated with the end of summer, and it doesn't feel like we've had much, if any, summer at all so far!

But still, early August is traditionally when the grain harvest starts, and at the time of the cutting of the first corn sheaf, the festival of Lammas takes place. Lammas is a shortening of 'loaf mass' as the grain was used to make bread which was then blessed and shared. And indeed the readings on the first Sunday in August are about bread: we read from the Gospel of John about Jesus being the bread of life, with the well-known line 'whoever comes to me will never go hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.' Not just the bread of life, but also the water of life – both are necessary. There is much more to say and reflect on, and if you come to one of the services on Sunday 4th August you will hear more!

I would like to be an avid bread maker but I'm afraid it's always been the bread maker machine that's done the work for me, and I have to confess that I do not have the patience or strength to knead the dough and let it rest for as long as is needed... However, if one of you is a bread maker, would you be willing to make a roll or slice of bread for the services in church that day (8am, 9.30am, 11am, 6pm - see the service information in this magazine)? We will bless and break and share it! Please get in touch with me if you'd like to share a roll or slice of bread for one of the services.

August is also traditionally the time of summer holidays as children and young people are off school, college, and university. I hope the weather improves and that time off is enjoyed!

Dear Resident,

Nearly school break-up time! I hope you have some lovely hols booked and also haven't found it too hard to think of things to do with your little ones for the six-week break! It does seem like an age doesn't it. Here's hoping the cursed weather improves!

- The pump track CEMP (construction & ecological management plan) has now been written by the contractor and agreed by the ecologist. This will now be submitted to the planners. The contractor - JB Extreme Landscapers - have confirmed that they will start work on Monday 12th August and work should take 4-6 weeks. Hopefully this means that it will get some use in the balmier weather before winter. The contractor assures me that all work will be performed within the working day and that they will keep noise and mess to a minimum. The MUGA will still be able to be used during this time.
- The Roseleigh development was heard by Tewkesbury Borough Council
 planners on Tuesday 16th July. A delegated permit was decreed pending 106
 contribution discussions. We attended and made a strong case that all 106
 should go to our parish & not to the wider Borough. We will keep you posted.
- We have applied for a grant from TBC to restore the K6 red telephone box currently languishing at the side of the community centre. If successful we hope to have it installed at the side of the main entrance and house the defibrillator within it. There are only a few thousand of these left, so it would be great if we can preserve this important heritage asset for future generations.

- The new tennis net was installed in the MUGA. We spent nearly £1000 on it so that we could have a self-supporting net that could be easily moved to one side to enable the footballers to have the full pitch to play on. Unfortunately, some have gone further on several occasions and have dragged it completely outside the fence and left it on the grass. It will get ruined, and we cannot afford to buy another, so please, if you read this, could you not do this & take care of it.
- More local honey should be available in the shop later in August.
- The land by the chapel on Banady Lane is now in its' final legal throes. The last clauses are being agreed by both parties, and the ground has to be cleared properly as part of the agreement. I'd like to reiterate that as part of the legal agreement it will remain as a Public Open Space area for the future. The Parish Council will maintain it regularly, and no notice boards or structures will be allowed therein.
- We had another meeting with the M5 Junction 10 team regarding their proposal for Stoke Road through Stoke Orchard. At the Community Day we have planned for Saturday 7th September, they will attend and set up a presentation of the designs. Do come along to see what they propose and provide your own input.
- Finally, the new dog bin installed at the end of Dean Lane proved to be a little troublesome to put on TBC's collection schedule. I think it is resolved now but please let us know of this or any other problem affecting you.

Stoke Orchard and Tredington Parish Council Community Speed Watch



Information from our Road Safety and Traffic Management Officer:

Research has shown that where volunteers are seen on the side of the road as part of the CSW Scheme, the number of keepers receiving second letters is reduced to approximately 5%, indicating that the vast majority of drivers react positively to the CSW presence and amend their speeds accordingly. By comparison, out of the drivers caught by Community Cameras, approximately 25% are receiving a second letter. So the impact of a visible CSW team is evident.

Your group is the most active in the Tewkesbury district and it is doing a great job in providing data.

So far this year, on 16 sessions, your CSW identified 168 speeding motorists.

The camera enforcement team has visited:

- Stoke Rd, Tredington 6 times with 38 vehicles caught speeding
- Stoke Rd, Stoke Orchard 4 times with 5 vehicles caught speeding

Two further sites have been set up at Banady Lane either direction but have yet to be visited.

Your Community Speed Watch team is a group of dedicated volunteers concerned about speeding within our villages. Please support them by driving carefully and respectfully through our community.
